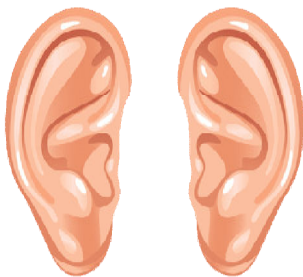
## Parts of the body:

For e.g. the child see television with their eyes,



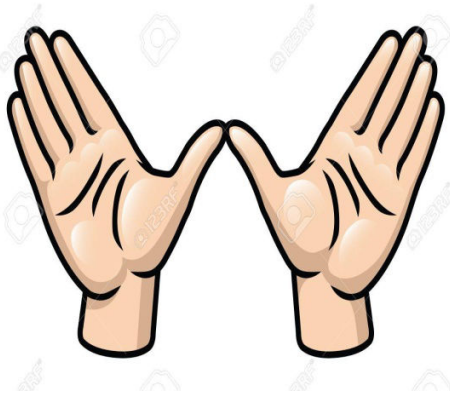
The child hears the music with their ears.



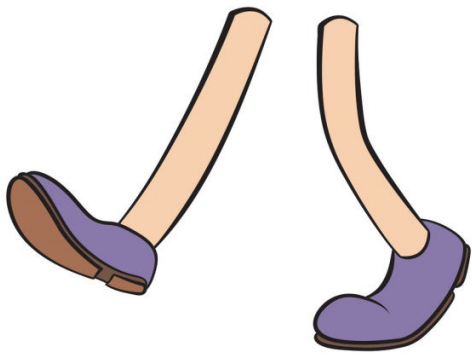
The child smells food with the nose.
